So in terms of how things are going is going well, however it's very slow during the day times as we've been opened for the day time for two weeks now and have 1 person order lunch. I'm sure it's just going to take some time for people to realize we are open during the days... Friday and Sundays are still our best times for sales asides from having events like we've had the past month. I am a bit concerned that with the weather changing we are still not seeing people come in to eat. For example last Wednesday evening the Persian meeting had bought a bunch of pizzas and ate in our dining room where there's a strict policy of not having outside food brought into the dining room. Another couple of issues is that the meetings that have coffee during the meetings are not cleaning and outing the carafes away and expecting me to do them which is not my job and there's a clear sign that they need to clean up after themselves. I'd suggest to tell all groups who do have coffee of taking their privileges away if having coffee if they don't clean up. The dishwasher is great as it's nice to know we won't be having anymore issues with it. However it's quite a bit smaller than our previous dishwasher and we cannot clean our baking sheets or pans in them which makes cleaning at the end of the night an extra 30 to 45 mins more. Also, we have noticed there are not only mice in the building but cockroaches too which is

very unsanitary and we have maintained the kitchen and cleaned it up but there are still quite a few holes in the kitchen for these to be coming in and out of the kitchen, and need these holes taken care of asap. Business is going well thanks. However, when speaking to Kim before he mentioned that with the board members used to always come in and support the kitchen. There has literally been a couple of you to come in and eat so when we talk about being supported, if board members came in more frequently that may bring in more people. The one day on Mondays where its bingo nights and the rest of the days the kitchen is closed at 730pm. I don't see the reason to be needing to stay open an extra half an hour when there's only been a couple of people come in after 730 for the past couple of months. And I was hoping, if you guys still wanted to stay open, possibly having a volunteer here to see ice cream and drinks for an hour as no one is ordering food any time after 715... there's one more fix which I know is expensive and I know it's not a priority, however, the sink in the back of the kitchen is completely useless and takes up so much space and cannot be used as a cutting board as the board doesn't fit snug with the extra space of the cutting board to the sink.

Also, I was hoping to ask you where you got the boards printed for the Alano club like the blue one which is on a stand to out outside the Alano to hopefully bring in more people. I've now got a few customers from upstairs for take home meals which they are loving. Just need to get more.
